## **How to Avoid Scams This Election Season**

### Phishing scams targeting voters can discourage participation and turnout in the upcoming election. Don't let it happen to you!

If you receive a text message claiming that there is a problem with your voter registration, mail-in ballot application, or other aspect of the election, take the following steps:

### **NEVER click on unsecure links or provide** sensitive information to unknown sources.

All communications from Montgomery County regarding voting information will be officially and clearly marked and easily identifiable.

### Report the scam.

Use the "Report as Junk" feature on your phone's text messaging or email application.

## Secure & Private

Mail-in ballots are handled with the same tried-and-true security protocols that are used for absentee ballots.



If you're a registered voter, mail-in ballots let you vote from the comfort and convenience of your own home.



## Easy to Apply

You can apply for a mail-in ballot using a paper application, online at vote.pa.gov or in person at your county election office.

## **How to Return Your Completed Mail Ballot**

Official Ballot

Yellow Envelope Marked "Official Election Ballot"

Pre-Addressed Outer "Return Envelope







Sign and Write the Current Date

Make sure to seal your ballot in the yellow envelope marked "Official Election Ballot" AND seal that envelope into the pre-addressed outer return envelope. Sign and enter the current date on the outer return envelope. Your ballot will be counted only if it is sealed in both envelopes and the outer envelope is signed and dated. Return only your own ballot unless a voter with a disability has designated in writing that you are authorized to also return their ballot. Mail ballots must be received by the county election office by 8 p.m. on Election Day.

How to Vote by Mail

In Pennsylvania, all voters have the option of voting by mail. **Use the QR code** below to apply for your mail-in ballot online today!

The deadline to apply for a mail-in ballot for the 2024 General Election is October 29, 2024, by 5 p.m.



You will need your driver's license, PennDOT ID, or Social Security number to apply online.

You can also mail the application to:

Or visit one of our satellite offices to apply for and immediately submit a mail-in ballot in person.

Return your mail-in ballot via the US Postal Service, at a Voter Services satellite office, or at one of the County's secure ballot drop boxes. No postage is required.

## How to Vote by Mail

### **Voting Outside of Montgomery County**

If you are a registered Montgomery County voter who will be outside of the County on Election Day, such as attending college in a different town or going on a planned trip, you may request a mail-in ballot.

Voters are encouraged to return their ballots as soon as possible to avoid delays.

### **Emergency Absentee Ballot Instructions**

After the deadline to apply for a mail-in ballot has passed on October 29, 2024, at 5 p.m. and an emergency arises that will make it impossible for you to vote on Election Day, such as unexpected illness, disability, or unplanned travel, you can apply for an emergency absentee ballot.



Keep in mind that your ballot will need to be RECEIVED by 8 p.m. on Election Day, November 5, 2024.



### Call 610-278-3280 if:

- · You need assistance registering to vote
- You need to confirm your voter registration status
- · You need to check the status of your mail-in ballot
- · You have a problem at your polling place that the Judge of Elections is not able to resolve

- You witness voter intimidation or harassment
- You have evidence of suspicious activity or election interference

 You see any suspected criminal activity, including threats of harassment, intimidation, or violence

### Montgomery County Emergency Communications Center Call 9-1-1 if:

 There is an emergency at a polling place, satellite office, or drop box that endangers public safety

## What You Need To Know as a First-Time Voter

### Who can vote in the 2024 General Election?

Any potential voter in Montgomery County:

- Must be a citizen for at least one month prior to the election
- Must be at least 18 years old on Election Day, November 5, 2024

### What do you need to register?

- Driver's license or PennDOT ID Card
- If you don't have either, you can print and sign the form available on the Montgomery County Voter Services website

### How do you register to vote?

• The easiest way to register is online

- If you don't receive your registration card within 14 days, contact Montgomery County Voter Services

What You Need To Know as a First-Time Voter

## Voting as a College Student

## If you are a Montgomery County resident going to away to college:

If you maintain your voter registration in Montgomery County and don't register to vote at your college address, you can still make your voice heard in Montgomery County through voting by mail. Just scan the QR below to apply for a mail-in ballot today!



Return your mail-in ballot via the US Postal Service. No postage is required.

Ballots MUST BE RECEIVED by 8 p.m. on Election Day, November 5, 2024.

### If you are here for college:

Register online to vote in Montgomery County! You'll need a driver's license or PennDOT ID Card, or the form available on the Montgomery County Voter Services website.





Voter registration applications are due October 21, 2024.
