A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP'S PARTICIPATION IN THE SOURCEWELL COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Procurement Code permits public procurement units, such as municipalities, to participate in cooperative purchasing agreements for procurement of supplies with external purchasing activities (62 Pa. C.S.A. § 1902); and

WHEREAS, Sourcewell is a service cooperative created by the Minnesota Legislature as a local unit of government, governed by local elected municipal officials and school board members; and

WHEREAS, Sourcewell qualifies as an external purchasing activity authorized for cooperative purchasing under Commonwealth law (61 Pa. C.S.A. § 1902); and

WHEREAS, Towamencin Township desires to join the Sourcewell cooperative purchasing program in order to procure equipment and engage contractors for projects with various Township departments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Towamencin Township Board of Supervisors authorize the appropriate Township officials to execute all necessary documents to join the Sourcewell cooperative purchasing program.
